### **Directions:**

#### **From Springfield on I-44:**

Going West on I-44 and take the James River Fwy exit. Go South on James River Fwy 3.5 miles to W US-60/W Sunshine St. exit. Go West on US-60 through Republic 5.5 miles to South on S Main Ave./S State Hwy P. Go South on S State Hwy P 3.6 miles. Stokely Farms is on the left.

#### **From Springfield at US-65/US-60 Interchange:**

From US-65 take the US-60 W/James River Fwy exit going W. Continue on for 10 miles to W US-60/W Sunshine St. exit. Go West on US-60 through Republic 5.5 miles to South on S Main Ave./S State Hwy P. Go South on S State Hwy P 3.6 miles. Stokely Farms is on the left.

#### **From Branson, Ozark and Nixa:**

From MO-14 W/US-65 interchange continue West on MO-14 for 14.5 miles. Turn right at State Hwy P/Public Ave. and continue on for 1.8 miles. Stokely Farms is on the right.

All classes are approved by the Southwest Missouri Hunter-Jumper Association toward year-end awards (EXCEPT WHERE NOTED WITH \* BY CLASS NUMBER!!). Show managed by Corinn Tattershall. If interested in competing for year-end awards, please review eligibility prior to the horse show.

**AWARDS:** Trophy in each division, ribbons will be awarded to sixth place with Champion and Reserve in all divisions. **\*\* Jumper classes will payback 100% of the entries (excluding office fee). \*\***

**WARM-UP CLASS:** An over fences warm-up class will be offered to allow horse/rider combinations to practice before riding their division classes. This class will be open through the day. Entries in this class will be allowed one trip over the posted course being judged. Each horse/ rider combination may only enter this class once during the day. Riders are responsible for telling the gate personnel when they enter the arena for their warm-up course. This class will be judged.

**ENTRIES:** Riders who are not SMHJA members will be charged a one-time fee of five dollars (\$5). This fee will be waived by joining SMHJA the day of the show. Riders may enter additional classes the day of the show through the show office. There will be an additional fee of \$25.00 if post show billing is required for any reason. Nonpayment will be considered the same as a bad check and will result in the board & officers being notified. Please **pay in full before leaving show grounds!**

*Pre-entries will be accepted upon postal/personal delivery until close of business on Friday, June 17, 2011 to qualify for reduced pre-entry cost. Please no phone entries and we cannot register entries without full payment or an open check. (The mailing address is listed on the entry form). Please make checks payable to **Stokely Farms.***

**HEALTH CERTIFICATES:** All horses entering the show grounds must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test for EIA. Avoid forgetting your test papers by sending a copy with your pre-entries.

**SCHOOLING:** We realize that horseback riding is a dangerous sport, however, in accordance with the SMHJA safe schooling procedures, we will be using the following procedures; The arena will be open for schooling **Friday, June 17th 10 am - 8 pm and Saturday, June 18th until 7:30 am** with a restricted number of riders, not to exceed 12, allowed in the arena at one time. We will be offering warm-up classes that may be used to warm up immediately prior to classes. Please be safe and courteous to other riders/jump crew. Schooling will be allowed in the schooling arena. Practice fences will be provided. Show management retains the right at any time to ask anyone displaying dangerous/inconsiderate behavior to leave the ring or show grounds if necessary without refund. **Please note: A \$25.00 fee will be charged for any horse hauled in and ridden or schooled but not showing the day before and the day of the show.**

**REFUNDS:** Canceled pre-entries will receive a refund if a veterinarian's certificate is furnished (less \$8.00 handling fee).

**CONCESSIONS:** A complete range of concessions will be available on the grounds, your patronage is appreciated.

**SPECTATORS:** We encourage you to bring your own chairs as seating will not be provided. Although service dogs are welcome, we would appreciate you leaving your pets at home. No admission fee.

**SMHJA DRESS CODE:** Riders should wear polo type shirt or shirt with collar (small left chest insignia allowed, but not t-shirts), conservative sweaters may also be allowed, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves (optional), and English style riding boots. Conservative colored ASTM approved headgear is mandatory when mounted. Formal hunt attire may be worn without penalty. Spurs of the unrolled type, crops, and bats are optional. Anyone not conforming to the dress code will not be considered an entry in the class. Showing, not to be judged, will be permitted.

### **HUNTER HACK DIVISION**

*Open. Hunter Hack: Manners and suitability for pleasure riding to be emphasized. May be asked to show on a loose rein, lengthen stride, hand gallop or collect. Open. Hunter Hack over fences: manners and suitability for pleasure riding to be emphasized. May be asked to show on a loose rein, lengthen stride, hand gallop or collect, with addition of; 2 fences not to exceed 2' a patterned course which will be posted that may include halt, trot and back.*

### **GROUND POLES EQUITATION DIVISION**

*Children/ Adult Amateur. Canter not required. Obstacles consist of four poles on the ground, to be ridden once around the area. Trot is not required in over poles class. Walk and trot are required in the flat class. If competing in this division, rider cannot jump higher than crossbars at the same show.*

### **LEADLINE CLASS**

*Open to riders age 7 and under. Lead line required. Walk only. SMHJA dress code not enforced, but ASTM approved headgear and footwear with heel is mandatory. Riders cannot show in any other classes at the same show. This class will be held as close to 12pm as possible. Horses in this class need not be registered with SMHJA.*

### **WARM UP CLASS**

*Open. One trip, at any time during the day, over any posted course. To be judged.- Ribbons awarded.*

31. **\*JUMPER PAIRS CLASS:** Open. A posted Power &Speed Course to be ridden by 2 riders on the same horse. The first rider will ride the Power phase (the first 8 fences). Riders switch after the power phase with the speed phase to be timed. Timing starts directly after the power phase. Faults incur time additions of 3 seconds with disqualification after 3 refusals. Fastest pair wins. Fence height 2'6"
32. **\*HUNTER PAIRS CLASS:** Open. A posted hunter course to be ridden by 2 horse/rider combinations. Riders will follow one another with one change of leadership through the course and the last fence to be jumped tandem. Fence height 2'6".
33. **\*CHILDREN/ADULT AMATEUR MEDAL CLASS:** An equitation class over fences. The top 4 riders may be called back for a ride off. Fence height 2'6"

*Open. Fences 2'6" to 2'9".*
