## DIRECTIONS:

**FROM WEST OF SPRINGFIELD:** Take I-44 east to exit 80 (H Highway/Glenstone). Exit right onto the off-ramp. Turn left onto Glenstone. Continue north and follow the yellow center line on this road for ten miles. The road changes names several times, but do not leave the yellow center line. Shadowbrook Stables is on the right side of the road ten miles north of I-44.

**FROM SOUTH OR EAST OF SPRINGFIELD:** From the intersection of 65 Highway and I-44 (exit 82-B off I-44) go north on 65 Highway. Continue north 8.9 miles to the Fair Grove exit (CC/125 Highway). Exit right onto the off-ramp and turn left (west) at the stop sign onto CC Highway. Cross over Highway 65 and go past the southbound entrance to Highway 65. Immediately turn left (south) on Shelby Road. Continue 2.5 miles. Shadowbrook Stables is on the left side of the road.

**FROM NORTH OF FAIR GROVE:** Take 65 Highway south to the Fair Grove exit (CC/125 Highway). Exit right onto the off-ramp. Turn right (west) at the stop sign onto CC Highway. Immediately turn left (south) on Shelby Road. Continue 2.5 miles. Shadowbrook Stables is on the left side of the road.

**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded first through fifth in all classes except the warm-up class (# 10). Champion trophies and ribbons and Reserve Champion ribbons will be awarded in each division.

**WARM-UP CLASS:** An over fences warm-up class will be offered to allow horse/rider combinations to practice before entering their division. This class will be open throughout the day. Entries in this class will be allowed one trip over any posted course. Each horse/rider combination may enter this class once to be ridden at any fence height during the day. Riders are responsible for advising the gate personnel when they enter the arena for their warm-up course. This class will not be judged. The entry fee will be reduced and no ribbons will be awarded for this over fences class.

Collection and lengthening of stride may be required.*

## HUNTER, EQUITATION AND HACK DIVISIONS

### LEADLINE CLASS

Open to riders age 7 and under. Leadline required. Walk only. SMHJA dress code not enforced, but ASTM approved headgear and footwear with heel is mandatory. Riders cannot show in any other classes at the same show.

Children/Adult Amateur. Canter not required. Obstacles consist of four poles on the ground, to be ridden once around the arena. Trot is not required in over poles class. Walk and trot are required in flat class. If competing in this division, rider cannot jump higher than crossbars at the same show.

**ENTRIES:** Pre-entry closes **Thursday, 25 June 2009**. Entries must be **received** by this date to qualify for pre-entry prices. (Our mailing address is listed on the entry form.) Entries may be hand-delivered to Shadowbrook Stables up until 8:00 p.m. Thursday to qualify as pre-entries. Entries will not be accepted unless full payment is received with entry. No entries will be taken over the phone.

Class post-entry fee: \$15.00  
Leadline entry fee: No Charge

**POST-ENTRY INFORMATION:** Entries made on the day of the show will be charged post entry prices (\$15/class). Competitors who have pre-entered at least two classes may add additional classes the day of the show at pre-entry prices (\$12/class).

**HEALTH CERTIFICATES:** All horses entering the show grounds must have a current (within 12 months) negative Coggins test for EIA. Avoid forgetting your test papers by sending a copy with your pre-entries.

**SCHOOLING:** The arena will be open for schooling from 8:00 a.m. until 5:45 p.m. Friday (06-26-09). The arena will be open for schooling from 6:00 a.m. until 8:45 a.m. on Saturday (06-27-09). Per SMHJA mandatory safe schooling practices, no more than ten horses will be allowed in the arena at any one time.

**SMHJA DRESS CODE:** Riders should wear polo type shirt or shirt with collar (small left chest insignia allowed, but no t-shirts), conservative sweaters may also be allowed, breeches or jodhpurs, gloves (optional), and English style riding boots. Conservative colored ASTM approved headgear is mandatory when mounted. Formal hunt attire may be worn without penalty. Spurs of the unrowelled type, crops, and bats are optional. Anyone not conforming to the dress code will not be considered an entry in the class. Showing, not to be judged, will be permitted.

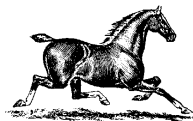
**STABLING:** A limited number of stalls may be available on the show grounds for a fee of \$25.00. Bedding will be provided. Please call to check availability and make reservations.

**REFUNDS:** Canceled pre-entries must furnish a veterinarian's excuse (horse) or doctor's excuse (rider) to the show management to qualify for entry refund (less \$10.00 handling fee). However, if the show is canceled, all pre-entry fees will be refunded in full.

**CONCESSIONS:** Drinks and snacks will be available on Friday afternoon and evening. Full concessions will be available on Saturday. Our very own king of the grill, Joe Ege, will be grilling delicious hotdogs, hamburgers, and bratwurst.

**SPECTATORS:** There is no admission fee for spectators. There are no bleachers available, so spectators and exhibitors are encouraged to bring lawn chairs. Please leave your dogs at home. We have plenty of our own.
